Overall Self-Response Rates in NC

44.9% of households in NC have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 12, 2020. The top performing state is Minnesota (57.2%). North Carolina is currently ranked 36 out of 50 states and D.C. for self-response rate. Nationally, 47.9% of households have self-responded to the census.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in North Carolina?

- **38.4**% of NC households responded to the census online versus 42.2% of households nationwide.
- **6.5**% of NC households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 5.7% of households nationwide.
