## Overall Self-Response Rates in NC

41.7\% of households in NC have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 5, 2020. The top performing state is Minnesota ( $53.9 \%$ ). North Carolina is currently ranked 37 out of 50 states and D.C. for self-response rate. Nationally, $44.5 \%$ of households have self-responded to the census.

How are people responding to the $\mathbf{2 0 2 0}$ Census in North Carolina?
$35.7 \%$ of NC households responded to the census online versus $39.3 \%$ of households nationwide.
$6.0 \%$ of NC households responded to the census by phone or mail versus $5.2 \%$ of households nationwide.
