Overall Self-Response Rates in NC

41.7% of households in NC have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 5, 2020. The top performing state is Minnesota (53.9%). North Carolina is currently ranked 37 out of 50 states and D.C. for self-response rate. Nationally, 44.5% of households have self-responded to the census.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in North Carolina?

- 35.7% of NC households responded to the census online versus 39.3% of households nationwide.
- **6.0**% of NC households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 5.2% of households nationwide.
