# North Carolina: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 17

## **Overall Self-Response Rates in NC**

**55.7%** of households in NC have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 17, 2020. The top performing state is Minnesota (69.5%). North Carolina is currently ranked 34 out of 50 states and D.C. for self-response rate. Nationally, 59.5% of households have self-responded to the census.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in North Carolina?

**44.1**% of NC households responded to the census online versus 48.1% of households nationwide.

**11.6**% of NC households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 11.4% of households nationwide.
