

Wayne County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending Aug 2

How is Wayne County performing?

58.2% of households in Wayne County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and Aug 2, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **59.0%**. Wayne County is currently ranked 40 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Wayne County?

40.5% of Wayne households responded to the census online versus 46.1% of all NC households.

17.7% of Wayne households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.9% of all NC households.
