

Alleghany County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 3

How is Alleghany County performing?

33.9% of households in Alleghany County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 3, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **51.8%**. Alleghany County is currently ranked 91 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Alleghany County?

12.4% of Alleghany households responded to the census online versus 42.4% of all NC households.

21.5% of Alleghany households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 9.4% of all NC households.
