

Catawba County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 3

How is Catawba County performing?

56.6% of households in Catawba County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 3, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **51.8%**. Catawba County is currently ranked 11 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Catawba County?

46.2% of Catawba households responded to the census online versus 42.4% of all NC households.

10.4% of Catawba households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 9.4% of all NC households.
