

# Randolph County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 3

## How is Randolph County performing?

**53.2%** of households in Randolph County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 3, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **51.8%**. Randolph County is currently ranked 30 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Randolph County?

**42.9%** of Randolph households responded to the census online versus 42.4% of all NC households.

**10.3%** of Randolph households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 9.4% of all NC households.

Historic census self-response rates for Randolph County were 66.0% in 1990, 65.0% in 2000, and 67.7% in 2010.
