

Pasquotank County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending April 5

How is Pasquotank County performing?

44.7% of households in Pasquotank County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 5, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **41.7%**. Pasquotank County is currently ranked 13 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Pasquotank County?

35.8% of Pasquotank households responded to the census online versus 35.7% of all NC households.

8.9% of Pasquotank households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.0% of all NC households.
