

Mecklenburg County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending July 5

How is Mecklenburg County performing?

61.2% of households in Mecklenburg County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and July 5, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **58.1%**. Mecklenburg County is currently ranked 19 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Mecklenburg County?

54.5% of Mecklenburg households responded to the census online versus 45.4% of all NC households.

6.7% of Mecklenburg households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.7% of all NC households.
