

New Hanover County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending July 5

How is New Hanover County performing?

58.4% of households in New Hanover County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and July 5, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **58.1%**. New Hanover County is currently ranked 34 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in New Hanover County?

49.9% of New Hanover households responded to the census online versus 45.4% of all NC households.

8.5% of New Hanover households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.7% of all NC households.
