

Randolph County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending July 5

How is Randolph County performing?

59.6% of households in Randolph County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and July 5, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **58.1%**. Randolph County is currently ranked 30 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Randolph County?

45.4% of Randolph households responded to the census online versus 45.4% of all NC households.

14.2% of Randolph households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.7% of all NC households.
