

Wayne County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending June 7

How is Wayne County performing?

56.4% of households in Wayne County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and June 7, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **57.0%**. Wayne County is currently ranked 38 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Wayne County?

39.3% of Wayne households responded to the census online versus 44.8% of all NC households.

17.1% of Wayne households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.2% of all NC households.
