

Catawba County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending April 12

How is Catawba County performing?

48.2% of households in Catawba County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 12, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **44.9%**. Catawba County is currently ranked 13 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Catawba County?

41.8% of Catawba households responded to the census online versus 38.4% of all NC households.

6.4% of Catawba households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.5% of all NC households.
