How is Davidson County performing?

46.3% of households in Davidson County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 12, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **44.9**%. Davidson County is currently ranked 24 out of 100 counties in NC.

- 41.2% of Davidson households responded to the census online versus 38.4% of all NC households.
- **5.1%** of Davidson households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.5% of all NC households.
