How is Durham County performing?

44.6% of households in Durham County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 12, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **44.9**%. Durham County is currently ranked 36 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Durham County?

- 42.5% of Durham households responded to the census online versus 38.4% of all NC households.
- **2.1%** of Durham households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.5% of all NC households.
