

Forsyth County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending April 12

How is Forsyth County performing?

46.1% of households in Forsyth County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 12, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **44.9%**. Forsyth County is currently ranked 26 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Forsyth County?

42.5% of Forsyth households responded to the census online versus 38.4% of all NC households.

3.6% of Forsyth households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.5% of all NC households.
