How is Jackson County performing?

21.1% of households in Jackson County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 12, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **44.9%**. Jackson County is currently ranked 98 out of 100 counties in NC.

- 17.4% of Jackson households responded to the census online versus 38.4% of all NC households.
- **3.7%** of Jackson households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.5% of all NC households.
