

Pender County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending April 12

How is Pender County performing?

39.0% of households in Pender County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 12, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **44.9%**. Pender County is currently ranked 69 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Pender County?

32.4% of Pender households responded to the census online versus 38.4% of all NC households.

6.6% of Pender households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.5% of all NC households.
