

Randolph County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending April 12

How is Randolph County performing?

43.7% of households in Randolph County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 12, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **44.9%**. Randolph County is currently ranked 40 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Randolph County?

38.9% of Randolph households responded to the census online versus 38.4% of all NC households.

4.8% of Randolph households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.5% of all NC households.
