How is Surry County performing?

42.4% of households in Surry County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 12, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **44.9**%. Surry County is currently ranked 51 out of 100 counties in NC.

- 33.1% of Surry households responded to the census online versus 38.4% of all NC households.
- **9.3%** of Surry households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.5% of all NC households.
