

Union County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending April 12

How is Union County performing?

54.6% of households in Union County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 12, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **44.9%**. Union County is currently ranked 2 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Union County?

51.1% of Union households responded to the census online versus 38.4% of all NC households.

3.5% of Union households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.5% of all NC households.
