How is Durham County performing?

58.4% of households in Durham County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and Aug 18, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **59.8%**. Durham County is currently ranked 43 out of 100 counties in NC.

51.9% of Durham households responded to the census online versus 46.8% of all NC households.

6.5% of Durham households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 13.0% of all NC households.
