

Mecklenburg County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 17

How is Mecklenburg County performing?

58.9% of households in Mecklenburg County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 17, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **55.7%**. Mecklenburg County is currently ranked 21 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Mecklenburg County?

53.0% of Mecklenburg households responded to the census online versus 44.1% of all NC households.

5.9% of Mecklenburg households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 11.6% of all NC households.
