

# Randolph County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 17

## How is Randolph County performing?

**57.7%** of households in Randolph County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 17, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **55.7%**. Randolph County is currently ranked 28 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Randolph County?

**44.5%** of Randolph households responded to the census online versus 44.1% of all NC households.

**13.2%** of Randolph households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 11.6% of all NC households.
