

Catawba County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending April 19

How is Catawba County performing?

49.9% of households in Catawba County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 19, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **46.6%**. Catawba County is currently ranked 14 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Catawba County?

43.4% of Catawba households responded to the census online versus 39.9% of all NC households.

6.5% of Catawba households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.7% of all NC households.
