

Iredell County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending April 19

How is Iredell County performing?

51.4% of households in Iredell County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 19, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **46.6%**. Iredell County is currently ranked 7 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Iredell County?

47.5% of Iredell households responded to the census online versus 39.9% of all NC households.

3.9% of Iredell households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.7% of all NC households.
