

Randolph County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending April 19

How is Randolph County performing?

45.4% of households in Randolph County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 19, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **46.6%**. Randolph County is currently ranked 40 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Randolph County?

40.4% of Randolph households responded to the census online versus 39.9% of all NC households.

5.0% of Randolph households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 6.7% of all NC households.
