# **How is Buncombe County performing?**

**58.3**% of households in Buncombe County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and July 19, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **58.3**%. Buncombe County is currently ranked 36 out of 100 counties in NC.

# How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Buncombe County?

**50.4%** of Buncombe households responded to the census online versus 45.5% of all NC households.

**7.9%** of Buncombe households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.8% of all NC households.
