

Caswell County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending July 19

How is Caswell County performing?

54.8% of households in Caswell County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and July 19, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **58.3%**. Caswell County is currently ranked 52 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Caswell County?

19.7% of Caswell households responded to the census online versus 45.5% of all NC households.

35.1% of Caswell households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.8% of all NC households.
