# **How is Richmond County performing?**

**49.4%** of households in Richmond County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and July 19, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **58.3%**. Richmond County is currently ranked 73 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Richmond County?

25.2% of Richmond households responded to the census online versus 45.5% of all NC households.

**24.2%** of Richmond households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.8% of all NC households.
