

# Surry County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending July 19

## How is Surry County performing?

**58.0%** of households in Surry County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and July 19, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **58.3%**. Surry County is currently ranked 37 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Surry County?

**39.1%** of Surry households responded to the census online versus 45.5% of all NC households.

**18.9%** of Surry households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.8% of all NC households.
