

Warren County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending July 19

How is Warren County performing?

43.7% of households in Warren County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and July 19, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **58.3%**. Warren County is currently ranked 87 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Warren County?

19.8% of Warren households responded to the census online versus 45.5% of all NC households.

23.9% of Warren households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.8% of all NC households.
