

Wake County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending June 22

How is Wake County performing?

66.9% of households in Wake County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and June 22, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **57.9%**. Wake County is currently ranked 3 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Wake County?

61.7% of Wake households responded to the census online versus 45.2% of all NC households.

5.2% of Wake households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.7% of all NC households.
