# Catawba County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week of March 23

## **How is Catawba County performing?**

In 2020, **18.7**% of households in Catawba County have filled out the Census questionnaire from March 12, 2020 to March 23, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **16.6**%. Catawba County is currently ranked 19 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Catawba County?

15.0% of Catawba households responded to the census online versus 13.1% of all NC households.

**3.7**% of Catawba households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 3.5% of all NC households.
