

Pender County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending May 25

How is Pender County performing?

50.9% of households in Pender County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and May 25, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **56.4%**. Pender County is currently ranked 60 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Pender County?

38.2% of Pender households responded to the census online versus 44.4% of all NC households.

12.7% of Pender households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 12.0% of all NC households.
