

# Union County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending April 26

## How is Union County performing?

**59.5%** of households in Union County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and April 26, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **48.5%**. Union County is currently ranked 1 out of 100 counties in NC.

## How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Union County?

**54.7%** of Union households responded to the census online versus 41.0% of all NC households.

**4.8%** of Union households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 7.5% of all NC households.
