

Caswell County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates – Week Ending March 29

How is Caswell County performing?

32.2% of households in Caswell County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and March 29, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **30.0%**. Caswell County is currently ranked 15 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Caswell County?

10.0% of Caswell households responded to the census online versus 25.3% of all NC households.

22.2% of Caswell households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 4.7% of all NC households.
