

Jackson County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates – Week Ending March 29

How is Jackson County performing?

13.1% of households in Jackson County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and March 29, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **30.0%**. Jackson County is currently ranked 97 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Jackson County?

10.4% of Jackson households responded to the census online versus 25.3% of all NC households.

2.7% of Jackson households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 4.7% of all NC households.

Historic census self-response rates for Jackson County were 53.0% in 1990, 48.0% in 2000, and 33.7% in 2010.
