

Nash County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates – Week Ending March 29

How is Nash County performing?

31.1% of households in Nash County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and March 29, 2020, **above** the state response rate of **30.0%**. Nash County is currently ranked 26 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Nash County?

23.1% of Nash households responded to the census online versus 25.3% of all NC households.

8.0% of Nash households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 4.7% of all NC households.
