

## Surry County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates – Week Ending March 29

### How is Surry County performing?

**29.2%** of households in Surry County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and March 29, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **30.0%**. Surry County is currently ranked 47 out of 100 counties in NC.

### How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Surry County?

**22.0%** of Surry households responded to the census online versus 25.3% of all NC households.

**7.2%** of Surry households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 4.7% of all NC households.
