

Swain County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates – Week Ending March 29

How is Swain County performing?

14.5% of households in Swain County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and March 29, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **30.0%**. Swain County is currently ranked 96 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Swain County?

7.2% of Swain households responded to the census online versus 25.3% of all NC households.

7.3% of Swain households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 4.7% of all NC households.
