

Wayne County: Census 2020 Real-Time Response Rates - Week Ending Aug 30

How is Wayne County performing?

59.7% of households in Wayne County have self-responded to the 2020 Census between March 12 and Aug 30, 2020, **below** the state response rate of **60.7%**. Wayne County is currently ranked 41 out of 100 counties in NC.

How are people responding to the 2020 Census in Wayne County?

41.7% of Wayne households responded to the census online versus 47.6% of all NC households.

18.0% of Wayne households responded to the census by phone or mail versus 13.1% of all NC households.
